




## Digital Index of North American Archaeology Berkeley Workshop August 8-9, 2019

### GENERAL INFORMATION

The 2019 DINAA workshop is taking place at UC Berkeley, in the Archaeological Research Facility, 2251 College Building. If you are coming from the Berkeley City Club Hotel (see map below), turn left out of the door to head east one block on Durant Avenue. Then, turn left to head north for one block on Dana Street, then turn right to head east for three blocks on Bancroft Way. After you pass the Hearst Museum on your left, leave the street and walk through the plaza towards the Law School for 450 feet to the meeting site. The ARF building is a small, two-story, brick building tucked away to the north (left) of the Law School.

For those driving in for the day, there are many public parking lots near campus. Two options near the ARF are UnderHill Garage and Telegraph/Channing Garage. The project will reimburse up to the maximum \$16/day rate. For those arriving by BART, the ARF is a 20 minute walk from the BART station. The project will reimburse public transportation costs and mileage. Please keep all your receipts.

## TRAVEL, ACCOMMODATIONS, & MEALS

Mileage: If you are located nearby and will be driving to the workshop, we will reimburse mileage at a Standard Mileage Rate of \$ 0.58 per mile. Please record the beginning and end odometer mileage and total number of miles.

Parking: Parking at the UnderHill Garage or Telegraph/Channing Garage will be reimbursed up to the maximum \$16/day rate.

Per diem / meals: The per diem rate for Berkeley, CA is \$66/day, and will be paid the meeting days. The rate will be adjusted for catered meals provided on the workshop days (two lunches and one dinner). First and last days of travel will be paid at \$49.50.

How to reach the hotel: Out of town participants are staying at the Berkeley City Club (2315 Durant Ave, Berkeley, CA 94704; <https://www.berkeleycityclub.com/>). If you are arriving at SFO or OAK, you may take BART to the Downtown Berkeley station. The ride is approximately 60 minutes from SFO and 45 minutes from OAK and costs about \$10. Exit the Downtown Berkeley station and walk south along Shattuck for three blocks to Durant. Turn left on Durant and walk two blocks up to the hotel.

BART is often a better option than Lyft/Uber or a shuttle because of traffic. However, if you have a very late arrival or a very early departure, or if you can share a ride with a colleague, Lyft/Uber or a shuttle may be a good choice. We will reimburse airport transfer on BART, cab/Lyft/Uber, or shuttle service from OAK or SFO. Please save your receipts and include scans of them with your email request for reimbursement.
